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2017 - PRE-EVENT CHECK LIST FORM

1: ELECTRICS & ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> UHF radio. Fitted and in working order. Microphone must have holder. <input type="checkbox"/> An orange rotating or quality LED light/s on the roof of the vehicle for use in dusty conditions. Must be unobstructed and easily visible from the rear & preferably the front as well. (Red, Green, Blue and strobe lights not allowed). <input type="checkbox"/> Horn <p>NOTES/COMMENTS</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> All lights working properly (indicators, spot & head lights, operate through dipper switch etc...) <input type="checkbox"/> A speedo, tripmeter or GPS that reads to at least one tenth of a kilometre. <input type="checkbox"/> General electrical condition. Added wires, switches, relays etc.. <input type="checkbox"/> Fuel pump. (For fuel injected cars with pump in fuel tank, you must carry a spare) |
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2: MECHANICAL & GENERAL ITEMS

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Mud Flaps of stout material for each driving wheel. (Mud flaps must be at least 100mm off ground when vehicle fully loaded). <input type="checkbox"/> Seat belts must be fitted to the vehicle for each crew member and worn at all times. <input type="checkbox"/> Seats Safe & Secure. <input type="checkbox"/> Roll bar padding & general head room. (protruding bolts, welds, brackets, zip tie ends etc..) <p>NOTES/COMMENTS</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Laminated windscreen. <input type="checkbox"/> Rear vision mirrors, clear & uninterrupted. <input type="checkbox"/> Interior safe. (sharp objects, loose items etc..) <input type="checkbox"/> Air Filter. Advise if air filter is adequate to prevent engine dusting. <input type="checkbox"/> Battery safe & secure. <input type="checkbox"/> Suspension & general mechanical condition of vehicle. (hoses, belts, fans, bushes, rubbers) Is it ready for a trip through rough & remote areas: dust & corrugations? |
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3: BOLTED/WELDED ON STRUCTURAL EQUIPMENT

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| <p><i>** Cruise cars do not require this item, however we would encourage them to fit central tow points (tow ball) in case a stiff bar tow is needed.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> ** A centrally mounted Haymen Reece type tow hitch on the front of the vehicle. This is for stiff bar towing and snatch strap recovering. Ball must be unbolted & stored safely in vehicle. <input type="checkbox"/> ** Rear tow bar and tongue, preferably Haymen Reece type. Ball must be unbolted and stored in vehicle. <input type="checkbox"/> Roof racks. If fitted, must only carry light material & be very secure. <p>NOTES/COMMENTS</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Jerry can holders. Safe & secure. <input type="checkbox"/> Spare wheel mounting points. <input type="checkbox"/> Underbody skid plates & protection. <input type="checkbox"/> If separate to haymen reece, safe, solid & marked tow points for attaching snatchem strap & D shackles. <input type="checkbox"/> Roll Bar – ROPS. (Not compulsory but strongly recommended in all vehicles. High clearance 4wd type vehicles must have ROPS or 5 star ANCAP rating. Lancruiser, Patrol, Hi-Lux, Pajero etc.....) |
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FAST LANE SCRUTINEERING:

*These items should be checked Pre-Event. All the below items **MUST** be rechecked at Fast Lane Scrutineering at the start of the event.*

4: COMPULSORY EQUIPMENT & LOOSE ITEMS

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Pre event Check list form completed & all items OK & or attended to.<input type="checkbox"/> A minimum of 5ltr of drinking water for each crew member.<input type="checkbox"/> Fire Extinguisher. Easily accessible, firmly mounted & fully charged.<input type="checkbox"/> A Snatchem Strap. Must be good quality and in healthy condition. (Not tow rope or chain). Must be stored so it is easily located and put to use.<input type="checkbox"/> 4.7t rated "D" shackle.<input type="checkbox"/> 20ltr legal fuel container. Must be full at the beginning of each day.<input type="checkbox"/> An Australian Road Atlas. Or maps covering the entire course.<input type="checkbox"/> First Aid Kit. Must be of good quality and carry sufficient materials for remote travelling.<input type="checkbox"/> Sleeping gear & spare clothes for each crew member. (not compulsory, but strongly advised if putting most of their gear on the spares truck).<input type="checkbox"/> Two reflective triangles.<input type="checkbox"/> De - Ditching shovel. Safely stored. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Rear facing car number. <u>Must be on the right hand side and clearly visible.</u><input type="checkbox"/> Forward facing car number. On the top passenger side of the windscreen & clearly visible.<input type="checkbox"/> A space of at least 600mm X 450mm must be kept clear on each front door or an area approved by the organisers, for the official door signs, which are provided.<input type="checkbox"/> Tools & other equipment to be carried in the passenger compartment must be safely & securely stored.<input type="checkbox"/> Flashing lights working & unobstructed.<input type="checkbox"/> UHF working. (microphone must have a holder)<input type="checkbox"/> Vehicle registration current. Vehicle details match label etc.. |
