

One-Day Fun-Day Rally Terms and Conditions

As a condition of entering and participating on any Road Boss One-Day Fun-Day Rally, each entrant and participating crew member must read, understand and accept all of these terms and conditions as listed below. Each crew member must also attend a verbal briefing which is conducted on site prior to the commencement of the day and must follow and accept all further rules, advice and instructions that may be given.

Rule #1. Its not a race! All road rules apply at all times and safe and sensible driving practices must be exercised and displayed at ALL times.

Each vehicle must have and be:

- Legally Road Registered and in a safe and road worthy condition at all times during the event.
- Carry at least a third party property or comprehensive insurance cover.
- Each car must have at least two crew members (driver and navigator). Other passengers/crew may travel in the vehicle up to the legal seating capacity of the vehicle.
- Every crew member must wear their seat belt at all times.
- No heavy or potentially dangerous or loose items should be carried in the passenger compartment of the car. (tool boxes, spare parts etc...)
- Each car must have a UHF radio. (A quality 5watt hand held is acceptable).
- It is highly recommended that your vehicle have a rear facing orange rotating beacon or bright flashing LED light for use on dusty roads/tracks/conditions.
- Carry a first aid kit suitable for remote bush travel.
- Carry drinking water for each crew member
- Have a tripmeter or distance measuring device. (smart phone app, GPS Navman....)
- It is highly recommended that you carry a vehicle recovery snatchem strap and a 4.7t rated D shackle.
- It is highly recommended that you carry a fire extinguisher in the vehicle. Easily accessible as well as safely and securely mounted or stored.
- While there is no specific age limit, it is highly recommended that crew members be 15yrs or older.

Following the route and using the road book/instructions for navigations

- Navigational route instructions and any information contained within the road book is to be
 used as a directional guide only. You follow them completely at your own risk and it is strongly
 advised and essential that you use your own common sense and discretion at all times. Due to
 the variable, unpredictable and ever changing nature of the terrain the recommended course
 travels, unmarked hazards, inconsistencies and omissions <u>WILL</u> be incurred.
- Efforts are made to include and warn of potential hazards, however you must assume there will be many more other than what is listed and noted.

- No road used for this event is closed for our exclusive use and therefore other traffic will be
 encountered often. All road rules and laws, in all States and Territories must be obeyed and
 adhered to at all times, without exception.
- The driver, vehicle owner and the person/crew and or navigator reading the route instructions do so completely at their own risk and assume all responsibly and outcomes.
- Information contained within the route instructions and road book are protected by copy right laws and must not be copied, reproduced, reused or retraced in any way.

Understanding and undertaking by entrant and each crew member:

Every driver and passenger, before taking part in this one day, fun day rally read, understand and accept an undertaking in the following form:

- I/we acknowledge and fully accept that I/we take full responsibility for my/our actions and the
 organisers shall not bare any responsibility for any damage I/we may cause as a result of our
 own actions.
- I/we also acknowledge that this is a Self Guided route and is not a race, timed trial or speed event & I am fully responsible for obeying all laws at all times.
- I/we state the nominated vehicle is legally road registered, carries it's own insurance (at least third party property) and is in a safe and road worthy condition at the beginning of the event and it is our responsibility for it remain that way at all times during the event.
- I acknowledge that never at any time do the organisers endorse, encourage, request or promote that any participant break any road law or drive or act in an unsafe or hazardous manner that may endanger themselves, property or any other person.
- I acknowledge and agree as a condition of participation that neither Straight on Pty Ltd, GIVIT,
 the Road Boss Rally nor any promoters, nor the sponsor organisations, nor the land owners and
 leasees, nor the organisers of the event, nor their respective servants, officials, representative
 agents (all of whom shall collectively be called "the organisers"), shall be under any liability for
 my death, or any bodily injury, loss or damage which may be sustained or incurred by me, as a
 result of participation in this event.

No pet Policy: As the course traverses private land, state forest, National Park and also utilises private business and properties a strict NO PET policy is in place on ALL Road Boss Rally events and activities.
